

The **Alton Farmers' & Artisans' Market** is thriving; our 24-week season was packed with activities to compliment your shopping experience.


This year we invested in new colorful signage!

limited income to purchase fresh fruits and veggies from local farmers.




How we put your 2022 Community Investment to Work
